

Licking County 4-H Shooting Sports Ambassador

When and Where Interviews: Friday, May 19, 2017 at the OSU – Licking County Extension Office

Who can compete: Any youth age 9-12 as of January 1 of the current year for Junior Ambassador, and any boy or girl 13-18 as of January 1 of the current year for Senior Ambassador.

Requirements: Must live in Licking County, must be in a Licking County 4-H club with a shooting sports project (Project #750-756), and have a good knowledge of all major shooting sports disciplines.

Ambassador Obligations: Obligations will be to promote Ohio 4-H Shooting Sports at Licking County shooting sports events. Represent and promote Licking County 4-H Shooting Sports at the Hartford Fair, in particular at sessions and events held in the Natural Resources area. Hand out awards at local 4-H shooting sports events and attend parades in the local communities. In the event that a Senior / Junior Ambassador is unable to fulfill their obligations, the first runner up for either the Junior or Senior Ambassador may be asked to complete the remaining term. After a youth has completed their Junior Ambassador term, they may not compete again for Junior Ambassador. Once a youth has been chosen for Senior Ambassador, they may no longer compete. They will be encouraged to apply for Ohio State 4-H Shooting Sports Ambassador.

Judging criteria will be based on the entrants' knowledge of Ohio 4-H Shooting Sports projects and program, presentation ability as determined by interview in front of a panel of judges, and an evaluation of the written entry. Dress is expected to be respectful. Formal attire is not permitted.
