

PB Chocolate Chunk Cookies

MAKES 16 cookies PREP 40 minutes BAKE 18 minutes at 350°

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- ½ teaspoon salt
- 1/2 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/4 teaspoon baking powder
- cup (1 stick) unsalted butter, softened
- ½ cup creamy peanut butter
- 3/4 cup packed dark brown sugar
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 tablespoon vanilla extract
- 1 package (11 ounces) semisweet chocolate chunks
- 1 cup dry-roasted peanuts,

- 1 Heat oven to 350°. In a medium bowl, whisk flour, salt, baking soda and baking powder; set aside.
- 2 In a large mixing bowl, beat butter and peanut butter with an electric mixer on medium speed until smooth. Add brown sugar and granulated sugar; beat until fluffy, about 2 minutes. Beat in eggs, one at a time, until combined. Beat in vanilla. Add flour mixture and beat on low speed until combined. Stir in chocolate chunks and peanuts.
- 3 Drop dough by scant 1/4 cupfuls onto cookie sheets. Bake for 18 minutes. Cool on wire racks.

Orange Bowknots

Dating from a recipe that appeared in the 1940s, this sweet citrusy bread dough recipe is tied in tende1· pretzel-shape rolls. Drizzle glaze from a spoon or squeeze from a bag with a hole snipped in the corner. Serve the rolls for brunch or breakfast.

MAKES: 24 ROLLS PREP: 45 MINS

RISE: 1 HR 30 MINS BAKE: 12 MINS 400°F

Directions:

- 1. In a large mixing bowl, stir together 2 cups of the flour and the yeast. In a medium saucepan, heat and stir milk, butter, sugar, and salt just until warm (120 degrees F to 130 degrees F) and butter is almost melted.
- 2. Add milk mixture to flour mixture; add eggs. Beat with an electric mixer on low to medium speed for 30 seconds, scraping side of bowl constantly. Beat on high speed for 3 minutes. Using a wooden spoon, stir in the orange peel, orange juice, and as much of the remaining flour as you can.
- 3. Turn dough out onto a lightly floured surface. Knead in enough of the remaining flour to make a moderately soft dough that is smooth and elastic (3 to 5 minutes total). Shape into a ball. Place in a lightly greased bowl; turn once. Cover and let rise in a warm place until double (about I hour).
- 4. Punch dough down. Turn out onto a lightly floured surface Divide in half. Cover and let rest for 10 minutes.

5. Roll each dough portion into a 12 x 7-inch rectangle. Cut each rectangle into $\underline{\text{twelve 7-inch-long}}$ strips. Tie

Cover and let rise in warm place until nearly double in size (about 30 Min.)

6. Bake in a 375 Degree Oven about 12 minutes or until golden. Remove from baking sheets; cool on wire racks. Drizzle with orange Glaze. Make 24 Rolls.
