- 1. Entries close Friday, JUNE 28th, 2024, at midnight
- Entry must be made whether a single animal or a group. Entrance fee is \$5 per lot entered.
- Check health regulations printed in this tabloid. Health papers must be presented before unloading.
- Open Class Beef Only Exhibitors have the option of arriving on day of show and are excused to leave at conclusion of show. Barn space will not be provided for open class only cattle.
- Bedding must be straw or pine shavings. All exhibitors must clean up their own bedding before leaving the fairgrounds or forfeit premiums and no entry the following year.
- No floor fans allowed.
- Each breed must have a minimum of five (5) animals & three (3) families
  exhibiting or the following year the class will be reevaluated by the fair
  board for inclusion
- 8. All cattle, regardless of age, showing under breed or all other breed classification must be registered/recorded and appear in the name of the exhibitor or immediate family member or family farm on the records of the respective association. All unregistered animals must be entered and show as crossbreed. Simmentals must be ½ or higher.
- 9. All Breed exhibitors must enter registration number during online entry. All Breed Open Class exhibits must present registration documents and animal to the Registered Beef Check-in location between 2:30 to 3:30 pm the day of show. Animal must correspond to description, tattoo and ownership as shown by registration and transfer certificates. Failure to comply forfeits all rights to show and/or award.
- Exhibitor number cards must be displayed on the back of exhibitor in the show ring.
- 11. Barns close at 11:00 pm every night.

## FEEDER CALF RULES

- 1. Open show for heifers and steers born January 1st or after of the current year
- 2. Enter day of the show. Entry fee is \$20 per calf and due day of weigh in
- 3. All steer calves must be castrated prior to June 1st. Any steers with testicular tissue will be ineligible to show
- 4. Cattle must be dehorned to be eligible.
- 5. May exhibit up to four (4) animals
- 6. Feeder calf minimum weight is 300 lbs. and maximum weight of 700 lbs.
- Stalling in Beef Barn allowed only if exhibitor has other beef projects and barn space is available.
- Calves will be shown by weight no breed classes no more than 10 calves per class.
- 9. The top five (5) overall will be paid as follows: 1st \$150, 2nd \$100, 3rd \$75, 4th \$50 5th \$25 or 70% of entry fee (whichever is greater).
