### RABBIT RULES

- All Stalled Rabbit Exhibits will be displayed in the Poultry/Rabbit building east of Carr Pavilion.
- Stalling is optional for Rabbit projects. Those wishing not to stall may haul-in day of show.
- Pens/cages are available in the barn for Jr. Fair exhibits on A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS. To be eligible to be assigned a pen/cage, Rabbits MUST Be present at time of pen/cage assignment. NO CAGE HOLDING VIA LOCKS OR FELLOW EXHIBITORS.
- Locks are required on all pens, no locks will be allowed on pens prior to being stalled. Locks will be cut and removed if used to hold a cage.
- Water bottles are required on all stalled rabbits. EXHIBITORS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE FEEDING, WATERING AND PEN CLEANING AS NEEDED! (See JR. FAIR RULES & INFORMATION #20 in this book)
- Exhibitors must be present when projects are being judged or premiums will be withheld. Projects will not be judged without exhibitor present.
- NO ADULTS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE SHOW RING EXCEPT SHOW OFFICIALS. VIOLATORS MAY BE SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION!
- Do not enter Mixed Breeds in the All Other Breeds lot.
- Exhibitor must own meat pen rabbits at least 30 days prior to the fair. Market rabbits must weigh between 3.5 - 5.5 pounds to be eligible for champion and the auction
- The judges' decision will be final. Once a lot is placed, class is closed. The judge will select all Market, Fancy, and Commercial Rabbit, Grand and Reserve Champions.
- Review "Jr. Fair Rules" located after the sale section in this tabloid for further information.
- Weighing of meat pen and single fryers will be Monday, August 5th of the fair between 7:00-9:00 AM at Rabbit Arena. Designation of animal to sell at weigh in only!
- Under and Overweight Rabbits will NOT sell.
- Bred and Raised Rules
  - A market rabbit project may only be shown by one exhibitor in one lot. A rabbit exhibited in the Single Fryer or Meat Pen of 3 are NOT permitted to enter or be shown in a Bred and Raised Single Fryer or Meat Pen of 3 Class.
  - All participants must submit a Rabbit ID form by the first Saturday in May to register the mother doe of the kits to be eligible to exhibit at the Hartford Independent Fair in the Bred and Raised Market division. The ID form must be filled out and returned

- with requested photos.
  - All bred and raised market projects must be bred, owned and raised by the exhibitor noted on the ID form of the doe.
  - Siblings from the same family are permitted to submit a Rabbit ID form for the same doe. Any additional doe sharing requests are at the discretion of the Hartford Fair Committee Chair.
  - At the July registration and tattooing, the doe and litter will need to be present. A letter or number from the mother doe will need to be part of the tattoo combination of the kit to be registered and exhibited.
  - We will place the 1<sup>st</sup> through 5<sup>th</sup> in each bred and raised lot. ONLY the 1st place rabbits of lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 will compete for their respective Grand and Reserve Champion in their division of Single Fryer or Meat Pen of 3 Rabbits
  - There will NOT be separate Grand and Reserve Champions for each division.

### TATTOOS ARE MANDATORY

All rabbits must be tattooed or registered (if already tattooed). Rabbits will be tattooed or registered the **THIRD SATURDAY IN MAY** on the fairgrounds in the Hondros Beef Barn 10:00 am to 2:00 p.m. Meat Rabbit & Jr. Rabbits will be tattooed on the **SECOND SATURDAY IN JULY** on the fairgrounds in the Hondros Beef Barn 10:00 am to 2:00 p.m.

There is a \$1.00 charge per entry. In case of death of an animal, replacement may be made with approval of advisor and Sr. Fair Board Member in charge. Replacement must be made with the same breed, sex and age of the animal lost.

**Rabbit Poster Contest**

The purpose of this contest is to demonstrate the Jr. Fair exhibitor's project knowledge, to stimulate interest, and to demonstrate to others the diversity of the Rabbit Junior Fair Projects.

1. Each poster must be made by the 4-H or FFA member.
2. Posters must be made using 22" x 28" poster board, displayed horizontally with stiff backing. (It is suggested your poster be covered with clear plastic)
3. Each poster must be clearly labeled in the lower right-hand corner, in a space no larger than 3" x 5" with the exhibitor's name, club or chapter, and age as of January 1st of current year.
4. Poster will be judged on:
  - Educational Content 50 points
  - Neatness/Appearance 30 points
  - Originality 20 points
5. Posters will be displayed at the Poultry/Rabbit Barn during the fair. Rabbit Posters must be in place by Wednesday Aug 7th at 10:00 AM
6. Junior Division 9 to 13 years of age
7. Senior Division 14 to 19 years

No entry fee - this is a free class - no premiums will be given.
